### CRIME REPORTING

The following table defines the Department's response to criminal and quasi-criminal activity. The data includes activity that is reported to the State of Illinois through monthly Uniform Crime Reports (UCR) as well as all other activity that is not required by the state. The criteria used for UCR reporting is more restrictive and would not reflect the broad range of activity to which our personnel respond.

## **PATROL**

### ***Calls for Service***

The New Lenox Police Department handled 4,204 calls for service for the month of December. A call for service, simply put, is any sort of activity police personnel perform which is logged through Lincoln-Way Public Safety Communication Center (dispatch). Incidents in this category are representative of events either dispatched or officer initiated. Calls for service include criminal, non-criminal and administrative activity.

### Commercial Burglary:

On December 6, 2011, unknown persons broke into Storm's Downrange Sports, 227 West Maple. An unknown subject entered the store through a broken window and removed 11 various firearms. On December 22, 2011, the store was broken into again by the same means. On this occasion, 5 different firearms were removed. Through various investigations, two of the stolen weapons, and one weapon that was not reported stolen, have been recovered. This investigation is pending.
