Non-Highway Vehicle Registration Permit Application

The Non-Highway Vehicle Registration Permit Applicant should complete the following form in its entirety prior to applying for Village registration. Applicants and drivers should read the New Lenox Village Ordinance No. 2940 (Article X, Operation of Non-Highway Vehicles, within Chapter 90 (Traffic and Vehicles) of the Village Code of the Village of New Lenox) regarding the Operation of Non-Highway Vehicles on Village Streets. It is the responsibility of the vehicle owner and operators to know and abide by all provisions of the Village of New Lenox Ordinance No. 2940. Upon completion, return this form to the New Lenox Police Department, 200 Veterans Parkway, New Lenox, IL 60451.

The following Operation Regulations are important for owners and operators:

- Operation is only permitted on Village streets. Non-Highway Vehicles cannot be driven on any township road, county road or state road.
- Operation is only permitted on Village streets when the driver has a valid driver's license and must be 18 years of age or older.
- Non-highway vehicles shall yield the right of way to all pedestrians and vehicular traffic, which constitutes a hazard.
- Operation is only permitted on streets from sunrise to sunset.
- Operation must be in compliance with the provision of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/1-100 et seq. as amended)

No permit shall be granted unless the following conditions are met:

1. The non-highway vehicle (golf cart or utility side-by-side vehicle) must adhere to Village Ordinance No. 2940.
2. The applicant must provide evidence of insurance in compliance with the provisions of the Illinois Vehicle Code regarding minimum liability insurance.
3. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license.

The applicant has received and read a copy of the Village of New Lenox Ordinance No. 2940 concerning the registration and operation of Non-Highway Vehicles and understands that the Village of New Lenox may suspend or revoke a permit granted hereunder upon a finding that the holder thereof has violated any provisions of the New Lenox Village Ordinance No. 2940 governing Non-Highway Vehicles, or there is evidence that the permittee cannot safely operate a qualified vehicle on the designated roadway. Any person operating the non-highway vehicle is subject to all laws of the Illinois Vehicle Code including Driving under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs. The passenger capacity of the vehicle cannot exceed the number of seatbelts in the non-highway vehicle. Any person, who violates any provisions of the Village of New Lenox Ordinance No. 2940, shall be fined in accordance with the Village of New Lenox Ordinance No. 2940. By signing this application, the applicant hereby releases the Village of New Lenox, its elected officials and its employees and agrees to indemnify and hold them harmless from any and all claims, liability, loss, damage, suits, actions, demands, costs, and expenses, including attorneys' fees and court costs, at law or in equity, including, but not limited to, any injury or death of any person or damage to property resulting from the operation of this non-highway vehicle on public streets. This indemnification and hold harmless agreement shall be binding on the undersigned, his/her successors, and his/her assigns.
