PATROL

Calls for Service:

The New Lenox Police Department handled 2,267 calls for service for the month of December. A call for service, simply put, is any sort of activity police personnel perform which is logged through Laraway Public Safety Communication Center (dispatch). Incidents in this category are representative of events either dispatched or officer initiated. Calls for service include criminal, non-criminal and administrative activity.
